



Ways you can set up your regular giving for All Saints', Malvern Wells with the Parish Giving Scheme



The Parish Giving Scheme is a national scheme set up by the Church of England to help individuals set up a Direct Debit to help their local church.

There are now three ways that you can set up a new regular donation with the Parish Giving Scheme: online, telephone, and by a paper form.

Why are regular donations so important?

The Church of England offers a Christian presence in every community. Together we seek to make this Christian presence the heart of all our villages, towns and cities: by our wonderful buildings; by worshipping together; by serving our communities and by sharing our faith and values. This valuable contribution to our community has a cost, of which 75% is met by your personal donations. For our Church to survive and grow, we rely on regular donations so that we can plan confidently for the future.

Why use the Parish Giving Scheme?

The Parish Giving Scheme gives you several benefits: regular donations are easy to set up and change; if you wish you can remain anonymous to the parish; and the Direct Debit guarantee makes the Parish Giving Scheme a very safe system.

Telephone

You can also set up a regular gift by calling the dedicated telephone line:

0333 002 1271

One of the PGS administrators will take you through the sign-up process – this normally takes around 15 minutes.

You will need to have the following information to hand:

- Your bank account details
- The PGS name for your parish: **Malvern Wells All Saints**
- The PGS code for your parish: **420642033**

What happens next?

You will receive written confirmation (by email or post) of your Direct Debit, including details of the parish you are supporting, the amount of your gift and the date of your first donation.

If you currently give to the church via standing order, you will need to cancel it by contacting your bank. You are advised to wait until receiving the confirmation letter from PGS before you do so.

How will the parish be notified of the donation?

The parish's representative receives a monthly statement, detailing the names of those who have donated and all the gifts given through the PGS. If you have decided to set up an anonymous donation, *ANONYMOUS* appears instead of your name on the statement.

What if I need to change my donation?

If you wish to make any changes, you can do so by logging into your PGS account at www.parishgiving.org.uk/my-pgs/ or by notifying a member of the PGS team by phone 0333 002 1260, email info@parishgiving.org.uk or in writing to Parish Giving Scheme, 76 Kingsholm Road, Gloucester GL1 3BD.
